

POLICY DOCUMENT

Pricing Policy 2014 to 2015

It is the policy of this club that all members, guests and visitors can access information explaining the fees that will be raised by their use of the Club facilities, equipment, and other services. These charges are in addition to the annual membership fees that are clearly stated on the Membership Application or Renewal Form.

Attendance Fees

Apply to any attendance involving the use of the club's indoor or outdoor facilities and/or equipment

Full, Youth, Family, Associate Members

- 'Independent Paddler': £1 per session
- 'Coached Paddler': £2.50 per session

Others

- Guests (max 3 sessions): £5.00
- Affiliated & Curricular: £1.00, with service from organisation's Coaching Team
- Affiliated & Extra Curricular: £2.50, including service from BCC Coaching Team
- Non-Affiliated & Extra Curricular: £5.00 per session
- Non-Affiliated & Curricular: £7.50 per session

NB. Individual members in any of the above categories will pay a maximum of £2.50

Course Fees

These can apply to any period of coaching under the guidance of a BCC Coaching Team member.

A course may be a stand-alone session, one of a series, or several sessions that a person buys into in advance.

Members: Full, Youth, Family, Associate, *Affiliate*

- £5 two hours, £10 half-day, £20 full-day

Non-Members: Guests, Visitors et al

- £10 two hours, £20 half-day, £40 full-day

Some specific courses attract fees outside the full control of the club; please enquire

Members' fees may be reduced if the course is supported by the BCC's Coach Education and Development Budget.

Equipment Usage Fees

Apply to Full, Youth, Family Members Only who wish to take equipment away from the Club.

Competition: e.g. marathon, sprint, wild water, slalom

- £1 per competition or training day

Trips and Touring (Independent Paddlers not based at the Club)

- £2.50 per day or part day, £5 per weekend (Fri - Sun), £15 per week

Sessions and Courses with BCC Coaching Service (Coached Paddlers)

- Nil, included in the session/course fee.

Facility and/or Equipment Usage by other Organisations

Fees are determined according to requirements and intended use, but the following is a guide to likely fees:

Use of facilities for the day, including occasional use of canoeing equipment: £100

Meeting room: £50 per half day.

Camping

Camping, including use of facilities, £2.50 per head.

FULL: £55.00 for 18 and over,
YOUTH / STUDENT / CONCESSIONARY: £44.50 for 17 and under, full time education, unwaged, retired, et al;
FAMILY: £125.00 for two adults and unlimited youth/student;
ASSOCIATE: £27.50 for those living more than 50 miles away with limited access to facilities;
AFFILIATE: £130.00 for youth organisations, includes one Full, up to forty Youth, conditions apply.
PLUS for all members £1.00 per session attendance fee, or £2.50 coaching fee, these include use of equipment.
